Admission Requirements for Domestic Applicants

Osaka YWCA College offers the Japanese Language Course to non-Japanese students who are willing to proceed to school in Japan, such as university (college), graduate school, junior college or vocational school. The students also would be able to prepare for New Examination for International Students in Japan and other tests in required classes (Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, English and General Knowledge "Japan and the World"). Foreigners living in Japan and Japanese people who are educated abroad are also able to attend those courses.

Qualifications:

- 1. Finished at least 12 years of schooling (equivalent to Japanese high school graduate) overseas or has equivalent qualification.
- 2. Intends to receive higher education such as proceeding to a Japanese university (college) or pass Japanese Language Proficiency Test.
- 3. Clear vision of purpose of studying.
- 4. In good health condition to complete long-term studies.
- 5. Proper long term visa status.

- ★Tuition fees have been changed. From October of 2024, through March of 2025, six months of courses will be 340,000 yen. However, from April of 2025, the cost of tuition has been changed to 370,000 yen.

Process from application for admission to enrollment and opening of courses

1. Application

The applicant or his/her representative is to submit the necessary forms to the office before the application deadline in person. In principle, we don't accept the application by post mail.

Required forms

- 1. Admission application: The prescribed form (with a picture)
- 2. The reason of studying Japanese: The prescribed form
- 3. Submit applicant's diploma of the last attended school or Graduation Certificate
- 4. Copy of Certificate of alien registration
- 5. Copy of Passport
- 6. Letter of guarantee: The prescribed form (The guarantor who lives in Kansai area.)
- * The forms that are not filled either in English or Japanese, please prepare an English or Japanese translation as attachment.
- * In case you don't have a guarantor, please contact us.

2. Screening

The first screening is examining your submitted application related forms. You or your representative will be notified of the results within 2 weeks after all your required documents arrived here in YWCA. For second screening, your remitter living in Japan or recommender will be interviewed. If the applicant is in Japan, there will be an interview with the applicant as well. You or your representative will be notified of the results within 1 week from the interview. Those who were rejected will be returned the submitted certificates (original certificates etc.).

3. Admission procedure

The admitted applicants should make an appointment with us by phone, fax or e-mail. In advance and come to school to make payment of 82,000yen for screening fee and admission fee. You will be given the instruments for placement tests, the Entrance Ceremony and starting date of courses.

Please complete the payment by the deadline. The payment can be made in 2 installments for the one year course, 3 installments for the one year and a half years course. Please ask us for more details.

The admission procedure will not be completed until the payment is made.

- * If you intend to study only for a short term(less than a year), or study only in morning, you will be considered as auditors. Please as us for more details.
- * This admission requirements is for who have proper visa status or Japanese. If you need to apply for student visa, please refer to a separate admission requirement form.




